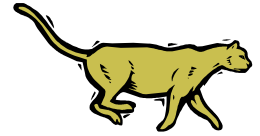

DAILY SCHEDULE

Doors will open at 7:50 am for the upcoming school year. Students will be considered tardy at 8:10. Chapel will begin first thing each morning. Parents are welcome to stay and participate during chapel at any time. The students attend a short devotional each afternoon at 3:00. Parents are welcome to attend during this time on any day as well. School lets out at 3:15. Parents can drive through and pick up their children under the covered area. Half day students are welcome to attend the full day the first day of school, in order to get acquainted

and become accustomed to the new school year.

LUNCHES

Students will need to bring their own lunches every day except for Fridays. Each Friday students are given an opportunity to order hot lunches. Last year the Friday lunches rotated between Papa John's pizza, Pepe's tacos, Chicken Express, and Carter's Burgers. Each lunch costs around \$3 per student. Money is due by each Thursday. The lunch choice and a reminder will be included in weekly newsletters. All students will be eating at 11:30 on these days. Parents are invited to join their children for lunch on Fridays.
