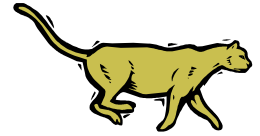

Parents are welcome to stay and participate during chapel at any time. The students attend a short devotional each afternoon at 3:00. Parents are welcome to attend during this time on any day as well. School lets out at 3:15. Parents can drive through and pick up their children under the covered area. Half day students are welcome to attend the full day the first day of school, in order to get acquainted and become accustomed to the new school year.

HALF DAY STUDENTS

Students picked up before 3:15 or dropped off after 8:10 need to come into the building through the door next to the Administration Offices.
