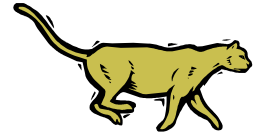

ORANGE JUICE MUFFINS

2 cups of buttermilk baking mix
2 Tbs. sugar
1 egg
1 tsp. grated orange zest (optional)

Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
Combine all ingredients and beat vigorously for 30 seconds. Fill muffin cups. Make a cinnamon/sugar mix and sprinkle the top of each muffin. Bake for 12 – 15 minutes. Serve with honey. Yield: 1 dozen
